## COVID Update

As per direction from NSW Health and Department of Education - If someone in your household (other than the child/ren that attend) tests positive to Covid, children can still attend OOSH. They are strongly encouraged to wear a mask and must have a Negative RAT each day for 5 days.

Please keep your child at home if they are unwell. If they display any symptoms, please use a Rapid Test or have a PCR test before returning to OOSH.

We will continue to advise you if we are made aware that a positive case has attended within our OOSH Community.

## Parking and Drop Off/ Pick Up

As you are aware we are now allowed to welcome parents into the grounds and buildings at OOSH.

Sign In/Out is inside the OOSH building with an extra iPad located on the pole outside the Admin desk.

Entry to OOSH in the morning session is via St James Rd (Gate 1) or Fairfield Avenue (Gate 6).

Entry during the afternoon session is via Fairfield Avenue (Gate 1) only (the St James Rd gate is locked after the teachers at NLS finish for Child Protection compliance).

The Fairfield Avenue entrance (Gate 1) will be closed but unlocked – we ask that you please close this gate after you use it as it will help keep our children safe.

Please do not park in or walk through the staff car park – the car park is for teacher parking only and is an unsafe place to enter and exit as a pedestrian (as per signage and school rules).

## **BASC Vouchers**

The process of registering and processing BASC vouchers is very complicated we ask that as soon as you receive your voucher, please send it through to us in order for us to begin processing and applying them.

You will be advised as each voucher's credit is used and completed.
